October 10th from 10am-4pm at the ACCA. Set up starts at 7:30am (down side alley along ACCA, unload in back; move vehicle to parking area IMMEDIATELY to help avoid congestion)

Christmas Market *Concession will be available

Alcohol vendors must follow AGLC & Alberta Farmers Market guidelines

ALL VENDORS at regular markets

We have started our market bucks cards again at our regular Markets

For every \$5 spent at your table, the customer will give you a card to initial. Once card is full, Customer will drop card off with Market Manager.

On June 6th, July 25th, August 22nd We will do a draw for \$10 Market gift certificate. It will be signed by Market Manager; If vendor spends it at your table, bring to Market Manager for \$10 cash refund and to pass gift certificate in.

OUTDOOR VENDORS

Outdoor vendors MUST have a proper outdoor market tent with weights attached to all legs. You are responsible for your set up, please ensure it is suitable for outdoors

Behavioral policies

There will be ZERO tolerance for abuse of any kind

Please do not take your table down until the market hours are finished. (Unless previously approved by the market manager) There is a 3 strike rule in place. After 3 strikes you will be unable to attend any markets during that season and next season. If you have problems with another vendor or customer, please speak directly to the market manager. When there is a customer complaint about a vendor, minor complaints will be a 3 strike rule. Unacceptable complaints will result in immediate dismissal of that vendor. Unacceptable complaints include but are not limited to drug use, alcohol consumption, fighting. NO warnings are required, or refunds given.

No smoking indoors, please use designated smoking areas only.

Absolutely no discrimination of any kind will be tolerated.

Vendor responsibilities

Always keep your area/space clean. Make sure your space is clean before leaving and remove your garbage. Have a garbage can at hand if you are giving out samples - You must adhere to Alberta health services rules & guidelines and have prior approval from the Market Manager

Keep your food safe certificate, cosmetic number or AGLC information on your table

Once market is complete, please wipe your table and chairs down. Please stack your chairs

Certificates must be provided to the market manager when completed. If you need to take the course and do not have access to the internet, please ask the market manager for a paper copy.

Market Manager

Will be responsible for “jurying” what vendors are allowed to bring to the market, as we follow the 80/20 rule. We only allow 1 of each resale vendor (example-only 1 Avon reseller)

80% means make it, bake it, or grow it.

20% means a resale vendor. Example Avon, including BC fruit.

Making sure each vendor understands the Farmers Market rules.

Has the right to ask to see the place of production and ask where your product comes from and if it is homemade.

Manager of the market will have space available for vendors starting the new season. At large markets tables will be assigned, at regular markets tables are a first come first serve basis. If you come to the weekly markets, we will try our best to make sure you receive the table to your preference.

Andrew Agricultural Society has liability insurance for the Farmers Market. This insurance does not extend to the vendors or their products. We suggest that you look into getting your own insurance, but it is not a must. To qualify for market insurance, you must be a member of AFMA. If you would like insurance, you can call;
