Don't miss the opportunity to enjoy a plate of Andrew's famous perogies. Located 2 blocks east of the Community Centre at the Rainbow Club.

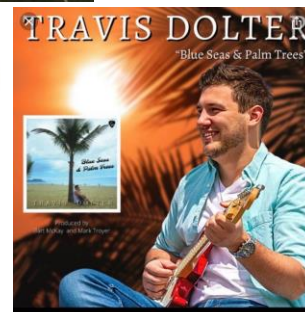
